

STEAM Academy After School Detention

When: Every Wednesday after School from 2:45-4:00 unless Mr. Flores cancels it for the week or needs to switch the days.

Where: Room 105 unless there is a meeting scheduled in that room.

Host: Mr. Flores

Who can be Assigned Detention: Any student not adhering to classroom or STEAM expectations can be assigned after school detention.

Who can assign detention: Any administrator can assign detention. Teachers can also assign detention to students as long as they have properly exhausted other interventions. These interventions will need to be documented and sent to the administrator upon referral to Detention. These interventions may include but are not limited to warning, loss of class privileges, parent/guardian contact, behavior contract, etc. There may be instances where detention is the immediate need (more severe disruptions or violations of STEAM expectations) and an administrator will need to be involved if the teacher feels detention is the first step of action.

Detention referral procedures: Teachers who assign students detention will take on the responsibility of contacting home to make parent/guardian aware of the referral and to discuss when they have been assigned. Students can be assigned detention on Wednesday during the day and stay that same day if the parent has been notified and is available to pick them up that afternoon. If a detention is assigned Wednesday, Thursday or Friday during the week then they will attend detention that following Wednesday. If a detention is assigned Monday, Tuesday or in some cases (with parent approval) Wednesday then they will stay that Wednesday of that same week. Parents must provide transportation home from detention and they must be here promptly at 4.

Teachers will need to complete the detention referral sheet and try to get the parent/guardian to sign the sheet and have it returned to you so that we have record of their awareness. DO NOT rely on the sheet sent home with the student as the only means of communicating with the parents. You need to have called or emailed them. Please copy the referral sheet and keep one for your records and send one to Mr. Flores.

There is no negotiating with parents on their assigned detention day. If they do not report to the detention Wednesday that they are assigned then they will be referred to Saturday School at MLK. If they fail to report to detention and also fail to report to Saturday school if it has been assigned then they will be suspended for 2 school days. **Please communicate this to parents.**

I will need a list of students you have referred to detention (and their reason for referral) by Wednesday morning of each week so that I can know who to expect.

Expectations during Detention:

1. Students will arrive promptly at 2:45 to room 105 for their detention. If they are late then they will not be allowed to enter detention and will be assigned detention again for the following Wednesday. They will have to call their parents to come and pick them up if they are late.
2. Students will not be allowed to use any devices of any type (cellphones, tablets, computers, Ipad, etc.)
3. Students will need to bring something to work on in paper format. They will need to communicate with teachers beforehand on work they can complete during detention. If they come with no work to do during detention then they will be asked to leave and they will be re-assigned for the following Wednesday. Teachers can also send Mr. Flores copies of assignments, tests, projects that the students can work on.
4. Students will not speak during detention unless they raise their hand and are addressed by the host. If students continually talk or are disruptive then they will be asked to leave and they will be assigned Saturday School at MLK.
5. Food and Drink will not be permitted in detention.
6. Students will not be permitted to leave the detention room unless it is an emergency so students need to take care of bathroom and water issues before detention.
7. Students will not be allowed visitors to detention and if students have to leave early before detention is over then they will be re-assigned detention for the following week.
